2024 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – CAMP QUEST**

Schedule/Camp Location

- Regular Quest Camp will be offered for 7 weeks: June 24 – August 8 (no camp July 4 or July 5),
- Monday - Thursday, 9 AM – 2 PM
- Ultimate Quest Camp will be offered for 7 weeks: June 24 – August 9 (no camp July 3 or July 4),
- Monday - Friday, 7:30 AM – 6 PM
- Ultimate and Regular Quest Camp are held inside the Welch Elementary School and on the grounds of Welch Elementary School at 750 New Road and Northampton and Municipal Park grounds. Participants will be dropped off at Welch Elementary.
- **The last week of Camp (Aug 5 thru Aug 9) will be held at Richboro Middle School at 98 Upper Holland Rd**
- Free swim will occur at the Northampton Valley Swim Club, 299 Richboro Rd, Richboro, PA 18954. Regular Quest members can pay an additional fee to be bussed to the pool at 2 pm. Free Swim is included in the fee for Ultimate Quest and there is no additional fee.

When can I drop my child off? What is the latest I can pick my camper up? What is the procedure?

- Drop off begins at 7:30 AM precisely (Mon – Fri) for Ultimate Quest campers. Children will not be checked-in or be permitted in the building until 7:30 AM. Regular Quest Campers can be dropped off at 9 AM, Mon - Thurs. ***For your child's safety, please do not drop off before your designated time, as we staff according to the number of children we have at a given time.***
- On a typical, **non-trip day**, pick-up will occur at 2:00 PM for regular Quest participants. Please form a car line facing New Road at the gym entrance of the school. A staff member will be outside with a walkie-talkie to call your child out.
- Ultimate Quest and Regular Quest swimmers will be picked up from the pool (Northampton Valley Swim Club, 299 Newtown-Richboro Road, Richboro) Parents must park and walk into the pool area to sign their camper out for the day.
- On long trip days, pick up will take place at Welch Elementary School at the designated time. Each child will still have to be checked out before we can dismiss them safely. We appreciate your cooperation!
- Please be patient, the first week is always a little slower as staff, parents and campers find their footing and adjust where necessary, we will get there!

What will camp look like for my child on a regular camp day?

- Ultimate Quest campers will have organized free play consisting of cards, ping pong, Nok Hockey and gym games in the morning when they arrive.
- At around 9:15 AM, Campers will be placed in attendance groups and assigned to a counselor. After attendance each day, a rotation of a variety of activities will be presented and campers will be able to choose indoor and outdoor activities with their friends according to their interests. Various sports, games and activities are selected based on camper input and attention paid to the comfort level of each child.
- Campers have snack and lunch (must be provided unless specified).
- Dismissal is at 2 PM for Regular Quest Campers. Swim after Quest and Ultimate Quest campers will be transported to the pool for an afternoon of swim and fun! There is a pool snack bar, the menu and price list will be provided when it is available.
- If it is raining on a pool day, campers will remain at Welch Elementary, (Richboro Middle week 7) and parents will be notified via email and text.

What are your staff requirements? What kind of training do they have?

- Our staff is amazing! Quest is led by two experienced leaders who have significant experience at camp. One leader is a certified teacher and has been with our camp program for many years. Our other leader is majoring in education and has also been with our Camp Program since being a camper herself! The remaining staff is rounded out by other college graduates and college students, some majoring in education. They are all super enthusiastic and very caring!
- All staff have completed three required background checks, mandated reporter training, and are First/Aid CPR/AED/Epipen trained and certified by the American Red Cross. All staff completes training on policies, procedures, and how to be FUN and keep campers SAFE, and create meaning, acceptance, and connection within the camp setting throughout the summer.

What happens if someone else is picking up my child?

- If your child is going home with a friend, or someone other than you will be picking your child up on a given day, please send a note in with your child indicating who will be picking him/her up. That person **MUST** be ready to show the proper identification to the camp leader in order for us to release your child. Prior written notification is preferred.
- In the event of an emergency or last-minute change, the parent must call the Camp Leader or the Camp Director and give verbal consent. The staff member on the phone will take the information given and record it on a "Verbal Consent for Release of Child" form. The person picking up will be asked to show proper identification in order for the child to be released.
- **YOUR CHILD WILL NEVER BE RELEASED TO ANYONE WITHOUT PARENTAL CONSENT**

What should my child bring to camp everyday and where do they keep their belongings?

- If your child will be swimming, a bathing suit should be worn under clothes or brought in a separate bag to camp. Campers should also bring sunscreen and a towel. You may also want to bring goggles (cannot cover nose) for the pool and/or money for the snack bar. **NAMES MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED ON ALL PERSONAL BELONGINGS.**
- All campers should bring a refillable water bottle with their first and last name **CLEARLY MARKED.**
- Your child should bring their lunch everyday unless otherwise specified (check trip itinerary to see if lunch is provided). Lunches cannot be refrigerated and should be packed in an insulated lunch bag with an ice pack. A drink for lunch is needed every day if your child would like something different than water.
- Your child will keep their belongings in a classroom during the camp day. Campers must take all items home with them at the end of every camp day.
- **All campers and staff must wear SNEAKERS in order to participate. Flip flops can be worn at the pool. Campers should wear well-fitting, comfortable clothing to move and play in.**

What if my child is taking prescription medication that is required during the camp day?

- Any camper requiring medication during the camp day must have a signed "Medication Log" form on file.
- All medication must be clearly marked with dosage requirements in the original bottle provided by the pharmacist.
- The Camp Directors or Group Leaders dispense and record the medicine daily when it is given to the camper.

What if I wish to speak to my child during camp? Are children allowed to carry cell phones?

- Cell phones are permitted at Quest, but must be off and inside bags at **ALL TIMES WITHOUT EXCEPTION.** Staff are required to check phones in their break room before engaging with campers at the beginning of the day. We take the safety and well-being of our campers, your children, very seriously. Cell phones at camp present a multitude of safety hazards, not to mention they are expensive and can easily be misplaced or lost. Different parents have different rules regarding what is appropriate for their children to view, whether they want their child's picture taken, posted on social media, etc. It is impossible to navigate all of this at camp. Camp is an environment where children and staff laugh, communicate, and enjoy physical exercise. There is simply no room for a cell phone. If your child is seen with a cell phone, we will instruct them to put it back in their bags. In the event the child continues to use their phone, staff will hold it until pick up.
- In the event you need to reach your child or the camp staff, please do not hesitate to contact the Site Leader (green shirt) and they will help you. This phone number is provided in the paper newsletter distributed on the morning of the first day of camp. You may, of course, contact the Camp directly with any concerns or questions at 215-357-5396 or you may call the Parks and Recreation Office at 215-357-6800 and someone from the department will do their best to help you.

How will I know what my child is doing during the camp day?

- A weekly newsletter will be distributed via email and The Camp Source App reporting on the week that has passed and what events are coming up the following week. We also encourage you to have THE BEST dinner table conversations EVER!! Your child's day will be jam packed with fun and there will be plenty to share!
- The **CAMP SOURCE APP**-You will receive an email to download the CAMP SOURCE APP. In the email, you will find your username and password. The Camp Source App is a tool where you will find our camp newsfeed, pictures, push notifications, camp trips and events, and any important documents you may need.
- This is our first year using the Camp Source App, please bear with us as we are navigating the new app as well.

How often are trips scheduled?

- Approximately 2 trips will be taken each week. **Even though payment of trips is included in your fee, each child must be registered online at www.northamptonrec.com by June 1, 2024.** For safety reasons, it is imperative that the camp is aware of who we are taking on each trip. It is also vitally important that we know we have enough tickets purchased and enough buses to transport the children. The Camp Leader needs accurate trip attendance sheets BEFORE camp begins.
- Due to the cost of transportation and the coach bus- there is a fee for the Camel Beach trip of \$35.

What should my child do on a trip day?

- If your child is scheduled to go on the trip, a set time to report to camp is designated in the trip itinerary and will be announced several times before the day of the trip. Your child must arrive at camp by that time, or they will miss the bus. **The bus will not wait for your child.**
- For his/her safety, your child is given two camp T-shirts to be worn, without exception, on all trips. If your child comes to camp on a day he/she is registered for a trip without their camp T-shirt, we may have extra shirts available, but a \$10.00 fee will be assessed for the cost of the shirt. (Extra shirts are not guaranteed)
- All trip information with dates, times of departure, destination, what to bring and pick-up time are listed on the trip itinerary in this packet.

What is expected if my child cannot attend a trip?

- Most campers attend all trips because they are included in the camp fee. If they do not attend, it is normally due to a family vacation or an extra-curricular activity that prevents them from attending. Unfortunately, we do not have enough staff to stay back with a very small number of children who do not wish to attend a trip. *There is no camp for children who are not registered for a trip.*

What is expected of my child at camp?

- Camp participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times while at camp. In order to provide all campers and staff with a positive camp experience that is safe and enjoyable for EACH child, the following guidelines have been developed.
- A caring approach will be taken regarding discipline. Camp staff will foster appropriate behavior through positive reinforcement, firm statements and redirection of activity. Your children are coming to camp with the expectation that they will:
 - Talk in a pleasant manner. Foul language, putdowns and bullying will not be accepted.
 - Be safe! Always follow camp and pool rules, bus rules and respect staff.
 - Treat all equipment and supplies with proper care and respect.
 - Show respect for the Parks and Recreation staff, bus drivers and fellow campers.
 - Aggressive behavior that is threatening to the child, staff or others will not be permitted at camp.
 - Have a positive attitude and have fun!
- Please review these guidelines with your child.

What do I do if something happens at camp and my child is unhappy?

- **PLEASE** talk to us! Your child's experience is why we are here! We can help! However, we can only help, give clarification or try to solve conflict if we are aware. Communication is the answer to almost every problem. Do not hesitate to contact the Camp Leader or the Camp Director. Ask a million questions, tell us the problem, whatever is needed to help your child have the best summer ever!

*The following document will give you all of the information you will need to prepare your child for his/her trips. ***Please note: Friday Trips are for ULTIMATE QUEST PARTICIPANTS ONLY. Quest trips are included in the camp fee but MUST be registered separately to attend without exception.** Please keep this information to use as a reference throughout the summer. Watch for updates or changes in the weekly newsletter!*

Tuesday, June 25, 2024

The Game is Afoot, Warrington

Campers registered for this trip should arrive at the Welch no later than 9:15 AM. Campers will enjoy a 1980's arcade all to themselves! Every game is available and no extra tokens are necessary! From Centipede to Donkey Kong to Pinball and everything in between! Campers will arrive back at Welch by 12:30 PM for a pizza lunch. Campers will depart for the day or will be taken to the pool (if registered) at 2:00pm.

Thursday, June 27, 2024

Tree Trails Adventures, Trevoze

Campers registered for this trip should arrive at Welch no later than 9:15 AM. Campers will climb and zip through the woods at TreeTrails Adventures. In the main park, climbers will discover the thrill of balancing on quirky bridges made of wood, cable and rope that span 10 to 50 feet above the forest floor. Trails are color coded by the degree of challenge they offer for beginners to experts. Upon arrival, experts will help campers into harnesses, show us how to use state-of-the-art gear and coach you through practice lines. Campers must wear closed toed and closed heeled (back) shoes, hair should also be tied back. **Online waiver will be sent- waiver must be filled out before trip.** Bus will arrive back at Welch at 2:30pm, campers will depart for the day or will be taken to the pool (if registered). **Lunch is NOT included with this trip. Please pack your child's lunch. Campers will eat their bagged lunch at Tree Trails.**

Tuesday, July 2, 2024

Ultrazone Laser Tag, Bensalem

Campers will need to arrive by 9:45 AM if they are registered for this trip. The participants will be divided into teams of 15 and sent into a briefing room where they will learn the rules of the game. After two teams have been briefed, they will be sent into a supervised Combat Room where they will be "under attack" for twenty minutes and groups will rotate in and out of play. Campers will enjoy an included pizza lunch. The facility also hosts video games, air hockey, and vending machines. Campers can bring extra pocket money so they can play while not engaged in a laser tag game. Camp Quest has exclusive use of Ultrazone during our time there. Bus will arrive back at Welch at 2:30pm, campers will depart for the day or will be taken to the pool (if registered).

Tuesday, July 9, 2024

Glow Bowling, Warminster

Campers will need to arrive by 9:15am if they are registered for this trip. The participants will be divided into groups of 6 and a counselor to form a lane. Campers will bowl under the neon lights! They will enjoy a pizza lunch with a drink. Fee includes bowling shoes. Children will need extra money if they wish to purchase an additional snack or drink. Campers will depart for the day or will be taken to the pool (if registered) at 2:00pm.

Wednesday, July 10, 2024

Top Golf, Philadelphia

Campers should arrive at Welch Elementary School by 9:30 AM for attendance and departure to Top Golf. It doesn't matter who you are, or if you play - you've never experienced anything like this! In the Top signature game, players score points by hitting balls (assigned using our microchip technology) into a target. The more accurate your shot and the farther the distance, the more points you earn. There will be a Top Golf pro to help the kids get started. While golfing, campers will enjoy a sandwich lunch, chips, chocolate chip cookie and a beverage. Campers will return to Welch by 1:15pm. Campers will depart for the day or will be taken to the pool (if registered) at 2:00pm.

Thursday, July 11, 2024

Dorney Park, Allentown

Campers should arrive by 8:15am if they are attending this trip. Campers will enjoy an endless amount of thrill rides like Stinger, where they will sit back and find themselves dangling from the scorpion tail seated face-to-face with their friends as they each witness to others' terror. Riders will be lifted up a 138-foot lift hill and then released to soar at speeds reaching 55 miles per hour through three inversions both forward and then backward. They will also enjoy the waterpark - including the Snake Pit with 6 thrilling new slides. Don't forget your towel, change of clothes and to wear your sunscreen! Between 12:00 and 1:00, your child will enjoy an "All You Can Eat" Buffet of chicken tenders, hamburgers, mac and cheese, potato chips, pasta salad and ice cream. Extra money will be necessary for those who wish to purchase snacks and souvenirs. We will depart from the park no later than 4:00 PM to return to the Welch at approximately 5:30 PM. Campers will not be attending the pool. **Please note, that many of the roller coasters require children to be 48" or taller to ride. Friday, July 12, 2024

ULTIMATE QUEST ONLY

iFLY, King of Prussia

Campers registered for Ultimate Quest should arrive at Welch by 8:45 AM. Children will experience indoor skydiving. iFLY's state-of-the-art wind tunnels are designed to provide a safe flight experience, memories that will last a lifetime, and a unique story to tell! Campers will be guided by world-class flight instructors who will take them through orientation and show the basics of indoor skydiving. Campers will also experience an interactive STEM presentation explaining the physics of the wind tunnel. Lunch will be provided on this trip (chick fil a). The bus will leave iFly at 2:00pm and transport campers to the pool. Once you register for the trip, you will receive a waiver to fill out through iFly's website.

Thursday, July 18, 2024

Arnolds Family Fun, Oaks PA

Campers registered for this trip will arrive by 9:15 AM. Arnold's Entertainment Center is one of the largest INDOOR family fun centers in America. Campers will experience the thrill of Go Kart Rides, heart-pounding Laser Tag battles, electrifying Bumper Cars, challenging Mini Golf courses, and an arcade packed with endless games. And don't forget to refuel with our delicious pizza options! With so much fun packed into one place, the excitement truly never ends at Arnold's. Campers will leave Arnold's at 2:00 pm and return to Welch. Campers will then be transported to the pool (if registered).

Tuesday, July 23, 2024

FunPlex, Mt. Laurel

Campers registered for this trip should arrive at Welch no later than 8:45 AM. Campers will enjoy 25 acres of indoor and outdoor fun. Campers have access to the outdoor water park with slides and pools. The rides are endless in their indoor and outdoor amusement parks. There is so much fun to experience at The Funplex that the campers will have to stop and enjoy their chicken tenders and fries. Campers will leave Funplex at 2:45, campers will return back to Welch and depart for the day or will be taken to the pool (if registered). **All participants should wear their bathing suits, wear and bring sunscreen and their towel.**

Thursday, July 25, 2024

Camel Beach, Tannersville

Campers should arrive by 7:45 AM for this trip, as the bus will depart from Welch at 8:00 AM. While at Camel Beach, your child will enjoy the Vortex and Spin Cycle- the only pair of bowl slides in the Northeastern United States! They will also enjoy Pharaoh's Phortress with eight waterslides, four story high tipping bucket, fountains, spray guns and more! The campers will receive a voucher for lunch. They will need extra pocket money for snacks, extra drinks, and/or souvenirs. The children will arrive back to Welch at 6:00pm. Pickup will be at Welch. Due to the rising cost of transportation (coach bus)- this trip is NOT included in the camp fee. **Fee will be \$35 to cover cost of transportation.**

Friday, July 26, 2024

ULTIMATE QUEST ONLY

Movie Tavern, Flourtown

Campers registered for this trip will need to arrive at camp by 9:15 AM. Campers will choose between the movies: **Inside Out 2**, where campers will follow Riley, who in her teenage years encounters new emotions or **Despicable Me 4**, where Gru welcomes a new member to the family, Gru Jr., who's intent on tormenting his dad. However, their peaceful existence soon comes crashing down when criminal mastermind Maxime Le Mal escapes from prison and vows revenge against Gru. The campers will enjoy lunch right at their seat (choice of chicken tenders, mac and cheese, cheeseburger or cheese pizza) while they watch their chosen movie. Food selection must be chosen at time of registration for trip. Campers will arrive back at Welch by 2:00 PM and then transported to the pool.

Wednesday, July 31, 2024

Urban Air, Willow Grove

Campers registered for this trip will need to arrive at no later than 9:15 AM. Urban Air is way more than a trampoline park! It's the ultimate adventure park where kids of all ages can explore all of the trampoline fun plus thrilling attractions such as Warrior Course, Sky Rider, Drop Zone, climbing walls and more! Socks are included! Lunch is provided and includes pizza and a drink. Campers will leave Urban Air at 1:00 pm and return to Welch, campers will then be transported to the pool (if registered). **A waiver is required for this trip: please see attached for waiver, the waiver is a "hard copy" NOT online.**

Thursday, August 1, 2024

Great Adventure, Jackson, NJ

The bus will depart from Welch Elementary promptly at 7:45 AM. The newest ride is the world's tallest, fastest, and longest single rail coaster, Jersey Devil Coaster, opened on June 13, 2021. Get ready for maximum speed, twists and turns. The coaster hits 58 miles an hour with a 130-foot drop. Towering 13 stories high, the coaster takes riders over 3,000 feet of track. Great Adventure has many, many rides for Roller Coaster lovers including: The Joker, The Green Lantern, Batman, Superman, Kingda Kha and so many more! Not a fan of the coasters? No problem! There is plenty more to do and see at Great Adventure. Campers will be given a voucher for **either** lunch or dinner and should be given extra money for the meal they do not use the voucher for. They will also need to bring extra money if they wish to purchase souvenirs. Peddler's Village

Campers registered for this trip should arrive to Richboro Middle School no later than 9:15 AM to head to Peddlers Village. Once there, they'll have the delightful opportunity to explore Peddlers Village and its charming array of shops before indulging in a delicious lunch and participating in an entertaining game show. Campers will enjoy a lunch buffet including a garden salad, rigatoni marinara, chicken fingers, mac and cheese, roasted green beans, french fries, cookies, brownies and soda/iced tea. Following lunch, the highlight of the day awaits: an engaging and interactive show titled "Cash a la carte, You're the next contestant," where campers will get to partake in beloved TV game show experiences, from spinning wheels to guessing prices and answering trivia questions. Welcome to the Camp App!



Welcome to the Camp App! NTPR is taking communication to the next level by using the Camp App to improve interaction and engage with parents directly through the App. Camp parents can now connect to as many camps with as many of your kids as you need to. Have one kid in Camp Quest and another in Camp Explore? No problem! Make sure to review this User Guide in full before getting started and use all the App features to enhance your camp experience!

Joining Your Camp

New Camp App users will receive an automated email from our system when your information is uploaded into our system. The email will include login credentials and a link to the App in the Apple Store for iPhones or Google Play store for Android devices. The default login is the email provided at registration, along with password 123456. The password should be changed to something more personal after logging in the first time. Once logged in, a **My Camps** screen will appear with all the camps your children are enrolled in. Click it to view the camp information and join the camp. If your camp is not listed there, please contact Parks and Recreation at 215-357-5396 to get enrolled on the App. Each email address will allow two logins on separate devices so both parents or other family members can have access to the App. **All system emails including those with login credentials come from noreply@thesummercampsources.com. If you do not see these emails, please search your system for them. Make sure to add this email to your address book so it does not get caught in spam.

App Menu Items

Once you have joined, the app will start on the "Newsfeed" screen. The Camp App menu is located at the three small lines in the top right of the App. When you click those lines, a menu will pop out to show: "My Profile", "Calendar" and "My Camps".

My Profile: *Updating Your Account Information*

Access profile information in the Camp App Menu. Click on "My Profile" in the menu to see or change account details, child's details, add a picture of your child, and see which camp you are currently viewing in the App. Emails cannot be updated since they are attached to login credentials. If changing emails, please notify your camp to create a new account for you.

View "My Camps "

Access "My Camps" information in the Camp App Menu. Click on "My Camps" in the menu to see all the camps you have enrolled in. Once a camp has completed it will stay in "My Camps" for you to look back on. Camps can also send information after camp ends to alert you of upcoming registrations or events.

Family Members Access

The Camp App will allow TWO users to be logged in using the same login credentials on different devices. This will allow for a maximum of two parents/guardians to use the app at one time. If different family members wish to view the app, someone has to log out in order to allow someone else to login using the same email and password.

Tracking Notifications

One of the best features of the Camp App is that it will send a notification anytime something is posted, uploaded or shared on the App so you never miss a thing! If there are multiple kids attending multiple camps, this could still be a lot to keep track of. In the top right of the App you will notice a **bell icon** which is your Notification Tracker. Anytime a notification is sent from any camps you are enrolled in, it will be listed in the tracker. Click on any notification listed in the tracker and it will go directly to the screen in the App where it was posted. All notifications for all kids in all camps are listed in order in the tracker.

App Features

The Camp App has many features to enhance your camp experience! When in the app, it will always start on your Camp Newsfeed. All camp features are listed in the bottom of the app to include: "News", "Documents", "Trips and Events" and "Gallery".

You will receive a notification anytime something new is posted in the App so you are always in the loop on camp updates, reminders, and activities. If enrolled in multiple camps at the same time, you may have to toggle between camps to see which camp the notification came from. You can do this in the Notification Tracker or by going to your "My Camps" list in the menu.

Here is an overview on what each feature provides

Camp Newsfeed: View any updates and reminders from your camp. Camps may also post fun and engaging content to let you see some of the things they are doing throughout the day!

Pictures: Both these features are listed in the Gallery menu item and separated by a tab on that screen. Camps can upload picture galleries with all the great pictures they took at camp or on a trip. Pictures can be viewed and downloaded directly to your mobile device.

Camp Calendar: Located in the top right of the App, click the Calendar to see all your child's trips, events, and activities. Check with your camp first to make sure that they are using the Calendar in the App. If you do not see your schedules here, your camp may have put them in the Document Center.

Camp Documents: Camps can upload all their schedules, manuals, handouts, supplemental material, and other important information they want to get to you in this section. You can view or download them directly to your mobile device.

Trips and Events: Camps will post detailed information about your camp field trips or camp events. You can toggle between both camp trips and camp events when you view this section and see times, descriptions, and what campers need to bring.
