2019 Trip Itinerary

June 24 – August 16

The following document will give you all of the information you will need to prepare your child for his/her trips. Grades referenced are the grades children are entering in the Fall. Please keep this information to use as a reference throughout the summer. Watch for updates or changes in the weekly newsletter!

Thursday, June 27

(GRADES 4, 5, 6)

Dorney Park, Allentown

Children entering 4th, 5th and 6th grades only should arrive at the Recreation Center by 7:45 AM if they are attending this trip. Campers will enjoy an endless amount of thrill rides, like Stinger where they will sit back and find themselves dangling from the scorpion tail seated face-to-face with their friends as they each sit witness to the others terror. Riders will be lifted up a 138-foot lift hill and then released to soar at speeds reaching 55 miles per hour through three inversions both forward and then backward. They will also enjoy the waterpark – including the Snake Pit with 6 thrilling new slides. Don't forget your towel, change of clothes and to wear your sunscreen! Between 12:00 and 2:00, your child will enjoy an "All You Can Eat" Buffet of fried chicken, hot dogs, hamburgers, potato chips, pasta salad and baked beans. Extra money will be necessary for those who wish to purchase snacks and souvenirs. We will depart from the park no later than 4:15 PM to return to the Recreation Center at approximately 6:00 PM.

Tuesday, July 9

Bowlero, Feasterville

Campers should arrive at the Recreation Center no later than 9 AM to attend this trip. Campers will enjoy bowling lanes with video screens, and arcade featuring 4D games and Mario Kart DX, and state of the art laser tag! Campers will bowl, play a round of Laser Tag, and enjoy a \$7 arcade card. Extra money will be needed if your child wants to enjoy more arcade games or have an extra snack. 2 slices of pizza and a drink will be served for lunch. Campers will arrive back at the Recreation Center by 2:15 PM.

Thursday, July 11

Palace Rollerskating, Philadelphia

Children registered for this trip should arrive at camp by 7:45 AM. The rink is reserved entirely for Camp Expedition and Camp Adventure participants. The children will be able to skate until 12:30 PM. (Skate rental is included in our contract; however, those who wish to bring their own rollerblades may do so.) A hot dog or a slice of pizza and a soda are included for lunch. Campers who are ages 10 and under will also enjoy the new Playzone climb through activity area! Extra pocket money is required for snacks and/or video games. The bus will return to the Recreation Center at approximately 2 PM.

Tuesday, July 16

(Grades 1, 2, 3)

Sports Zone, Southampton

Children entering grades 1, 2 and 3 should arrive by 8:30 AM at the Recreation Center for attendance and departure to Sports Zone in Southampton. Once there, the kids will have a blast playing Slam Ball, Space Jump, Rock Climbing, shooting hoops on the Basketball court, and battling it out in the Blast Zone and Cosmic Dodge Ball! Pizza and a drink will be provided for lunch. Children may bring extra money for arcade games. The bus will arrive back at the Recreation Center by 1:00 PM.

Wednesday, July 17 (Grades 4, 5, 6) Top Golf, Mt. Laurel NJ

Campers should arrive at the Recreation Center at 8:00 AM if they are registered on this trip. Topgolf is the premier golf entertainment complex where the competition of sport meets your favorite local hangout. Campers will challenge friends to addictive point-scoring golf games that anyone can play year-round. Just picture a 240-yard outfield with dartboard-like targets in the ground. The closer to the center or “bull’s-eye” you get and the farther out you hit your microchipped balls, the more points you receive. It’s not golf – it’s Topgolf. Give it a shot! Campers will enjoy a lunch of chicken tenders or cheeseburger, tator tots, and a drink. Campers will arrive back at the Recreation Center by 1:30 PM.

Thursday, July 18 (Grades 1, 2, 3) Dutch Wonderland, Lancaster

Children registered for this trip should arrive at camp by 7:30 AM. We will be traveling by coach bus since it is a longer trip and smaller children! While there, the children will enjoy family fun rides and some rides that are just for kids. Be sure to pack a bathing suit and towel for Duke’s Lagoon! From 12:30 until 1:30 PM the children will enjoy a huge buffet of hamburgers, hot dogs, chicken tenders, watermelon slices, potato chips and ice cream for dessert! Campers will arrive back at the Recreation Center by 5:45 PM. Extra money will be needed for snacks, drinks and souvenirs.

Thursday, August 1 Shrek, Jr, New Hope

Children can select their lunch option: Ham and Cheese, Turkey and Cheese, Uncrustable, or a meal voucher for an entrée and drink. All participants should wear their bathing suits, wear and bring sunscreen, and don't forget your towel! (Grades 4, 5, 6)
